

**HOUSTON COUNTY SCHOOLS
REMOTE LEARNING COMPACT
GRADES K-5**

All Houston County students and families are expected to adhere to expectations in the *Code of Conduct*, *Acceptable Use Policy*, and the *Houston County Revised Student/Parent Remote Learning Guide*. Any concerns, obstacles to learning, or questions pertaining to remote learning should be directed to building administrators before signing this compact.

Students will:

- Maintain passing grades/acceptable mastery levels in core content areas.
- Log in every school day before 11:59 p.m. to participate in classes. **Students will be counted absent if they fail to log in before 11:59 p.m.** on the scheduled school day. If your student loses internet access due to an unplanned outage or event in the home, you should call the school before the end of the next school day to be counted present.
- Submit all required work for the class/subject area each day by 11:59 p.m. **Failure to submit all required assignments as scheduled may result in an absence for the day.**
- Attend required in-person testing (TNReady, Benchmark, and Universal Screeners) at the school while adhering to social distancing guidelines.

Parents and Supporting Adults will:

- Notify the teacher immediately if assignments cannot be completed due to technical difficulties.
- Respond to communication via email and/or phone calls with teachers and other school personnel within one business day.
- Ensure consistent remote attendance of their child, providing required documentation for any excused absences.

School staff will:

- Develop standards-based lessons for all students.
- Follow accommodations stated in IEP and 504 documents.
- Provide instructional resources and materials for all students.
- Communicate with parents/students about grades and develop a grade improvement plan as needed.

By signing below I am agreeing to the above expectations. **I understand if the student does not maintain passing grades and acceptable attendance, he/she may be required to return to in-person learning.** If a medical exemption is warranted, documentation from a medical doctor will be required to remain a remote learner as well as a meeting with the school administrator to develop a contract for grade/attendance improvement.
